International study programmes in English

K.H.Kempen University College is a university college with eleven departments and 7,000 students. K.H.Kempen University College has always been an impulse for regional development in the Kempen, a dynamic region in Flanders, the Dutch-speaking part of Belgium.

The university college in its present form was founded in 1995. In 2002 K.H.Kempen University College formed an association with the Catholic University of Leuven, eleven other university colleges (Hogescolen) and the Catholic University of Brussels. Together, its partners have more than 70,000 students in 23 cities across Flanders.



K.H.Kempen University College participates in the LIFELONG LEARNING PROGRAMME, involving both student and teacher mobility, pilot projects and curriculum development. There is also active participation in development projects and in ERASMUS BELGICA, the exchange programme for Belgium's different language communities.

Business Management 30 ects

Participants gain practical business knowledge and a range of skills that will equip them well for future professional business life.

International ICT 60 ects

This academic Master programme of ICT provides participants with a thorough knowledge of information technology.

Office Management 30-60 ects

Practical business, language knowledge and a range of office management skills are trained.

International Microbiology (IMIB) 20 – 30 ects

A thorough study of support and regulation, molecular and microbial systems. We look at micro-organisms as a threat or as a benefit.

The International Class for Teacher Education 20 or 30 ects

Together with three other Flemish university colleges we organize an International Class on educational subjects: Communication and Expression, Diversity, Culture, Society and Teaching in Europe.

Flanders' Heritage 20 ects

Knowledge, culture and crafts, a structured view on primary and secondary education in Flanders with a practical and comparative approach.

Flanders Tour – International Nursing-Midwifery Programme: On Diversity and Unity 3 ects

Six themes on a multicultural approach to health care are dealt with at different university colleges in Flanders.

Dealing with Global Challenges 6 ects

How to integrate contemporary challenges and international perspectives in professional behaviour and functioning.

Entrepreneurship for Starters 5 ects

Small business projects for non-business students. The student starts in a group his own fictional company in a protected environment.
